# First Things First - Election Day

We are excited to have a number of Dems interested in representing the people of our townships, county, districts, and state. We encourage you to participate in nominating the Democratic candidates for this very important mid-term general election. A list of candidates is on page 2. It's time for Dems to get it goin' on!

Tuesday May 8 is the big day for the primary election. If you have not voted early/absentee, you can venture to any one of the vote centers listed on the last page to cast your ballot. The polls open at 6 am and close at 6 pm. All voters present in line at 6 pm will be able to vote.

Be sure to have appropriate ID when you arrive at the polls. Accepted ID includes:

Indiana Driver's License (current or expired no earlier 11/8/16) Indiana State ID (current or expired no earlier than 11/8/16)

\*Note: Paper interim BMV photo ID's are valid Military/Veteran's ID (no expiration date required) US Passport (current or expired no earlier than 11/8/16)

Indiana State School ID (current or expired no earlier than 11/8/16) \*Note: IU ID's do not have an expiration date and are not valid

\*Note: Goshen Resident ID (not state issued) is not valid for voting
